My cancer has been an opportunity for God to really minister to me in my life, work, and relationships.

Groups specific to my coaching niche (s): I work primarily with executives, executive directors of non-profits, and "self-employed" clients such as brokers, insurance executives, and entrepreneurs. My ideal client is exceptionally bright, very motivated, yet perhaps stuck due to a new job challenge, contemplated career change, big decision crossroads, or experiencing stress or conflict in the workplace. They may feel they have hit a plateau, and hire me to help them define and attain the next level in their work.

Guest speaker for churches or parachurch organizations __See above; I have also worked as a facilitator for groups such as a pastor search committee; women in recovery retreat; and non-profit staffs seeking to develop teamwork. Facilitation work is something I am professionally trained in and get great reviews on my work.

Professional conferences/special interest groups: Some might be interested in talking about how breast cancer has challenged my faith, and how I came to understand myself, God, my work, and personal relationships so much more. I'm told over and over again what an "inspiration" I am to others (although that is extremely humbling to me, and at times baffling to me). Perhaps God wants me to share some of my experiences at some point. Although a naturally shy and private person, I would be willing to stretch if it would help others. I also love public speaking, breaking through my shyness. I do about 10-12 talks, seminars, and facilitations a year (in addition to my full-time coaching practice).

I am open to talking with any group. One reason I left my staff position at one of the largest non-denominational churches in Baltimore was to have a greater impact on the lost. You often don't find them in the churches!
